INSTITUTIONAL BUILDING AGREEMENT

Withing the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding signed on July 24, 2013 in Brussels between the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Serbia (CCIS) and the Kosovo Chamber of Commerce (KCC);

Considering the benefits that the business communities could draw from the establishment of sustainable institutional relations between the CCIS and the KCC;

Mr. Marko Čadež
President of the CCIS

And

Mr. Safet Gerxhaliu,
President of the KCC

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

A representative of the CCIS nominated by March 1st, 2015, will be posted in Priština at the premises of the Belgrade's liaison officer in Priština as of April 15th, 2015, and vice versa a representative of the KCC will be nominated by March 1st, 2015 and will be posted at the premises of the Priština liaison officer in Belgrade as of April 15th, 2015.

Article 2

The mission of the Chamber representative will be to enable direct contact between two chambers in all relevant issues.

Article 3

Both parties agree to review the terms of the agreement within one year and to develop additional institutional building activities accordingly.

Article 4

Any modifications and amendments to this agreement must be approved by the competent bodies of each organization.

Article 5

This agreement may be terminated by either party by written notice to the other party within 30 days notice.

The present agreement shall enter into force upon its signature.
